VISUAL ARTS CLASSES:

YOU ARE AUTHOR AND AN ILLUSTRATOR:

Write and illustrate a book! Veteran instructors, Liz Mowrey and David Groth, offer writing tips and teach techniques of drawing and illustrating in this fun week in which each participant creates a book of their own. Students must be going into **grades 4-8**. Join the Fun!

CARTOONIVERSITY: A unique opportunity to work with professional cartoonist, Jeff Johnson from Seattle, to learn the elements of cartooning: character development, expression, action/movement, layout, exaggeration, etc. through a series of fun, creative projects. Take home your class Cartooniversity yearbook!"

PLAYING WITH DIGITAL PHOTOGRAPHS:

Would you like to change the look of bad photos, learn to crop them or create new images from them? Creatively change photographs with Photoshop Elements and learn to create your own PowerPoint show of your photos. Your guide to this digital world is Don Watson. Digital Photography has long been his passion and hobby. He will help you through the digital maze and you'll have fun doing it.

GLASS FUSION: Students in **grades 4-8**, create your own fused glass necklaces, earrings, magnets, mirror, ornaments, sun catcher, or wind chimes with glass artist, Kim Huender. Learn about different types of glass, how to cut and put pieces together to have beautiful and functional art pieces.

JEWELRY DESIGN!!!: Learn how to make bracelets, earrings, necklaces and some surprising fun stuff. Make these beautiful items with glass, silver, paper, shells and fresh water pearls with guidance from Jan Hallmark.

MOSAICS: Create your own design using porcelain tiles, ceramic tile pieces and glass beads. Take home your mosaic trivet and mosaic wall hanging. Working with artist Jan Wilhelm, the class will design a community mosaic art piece in addition to their own work. Advanced mosaic students will choose from mosaic combined with an etched mirror, cement cast mosaic or an exterior mosaic on cement backer.

MUD WORKS!: Instructor, Carol Uptagrafft, will help you get your hands dirty! Learn pinch, slab and coil methods while working on hand built projects. Learn glazing techniques and tiles too.

OIL PASTELS: Create a picture using oil pastels, the medium that lets you paint with a crayon! Instructor, Liz Mowrey, will lead you into the techniques of "painting" with oil pastels and provide you with a variety of pictures (animals, buildings, cars, landscapes, etc.) to choose from (or bring your own). A finished piece will be created on good quality black paper, which enhances the brilliant colors available in the oil pastels.

SCRAP BOOK ART: Stamp your way through your photos as you make a scrapbook that is fun, creative and uniquely your own. Instructor, Jessica Hammond, will help you create additional projects including cards, mini-albums and more.

SCRATCHBOARD ART: Bob Brunn will teach you the method to engrave your own design in a Scratchboard to reveal your picture, resembling a beautiful etching.

SILK PAINTING: Kim Torgerson teaches this fun class. Learn the technique of painting on silk with brilliant color dyes. Silk fabric with an artistic look.

IN THE STYLE OF THE MASTERS: You will explore a variety of painting styles inspired by famous artists of the past. Bill Burch will help you recreate the styles of Picasso, O'Keefe, Escher, Van Gough, Seurat & Pollack.

PERFORMING ARTS CLASSES:

CLOWNING AROUND: Have you discovered your "inner clown" yet? Terry Barnard "Corky the Clown" helps you develop your own clown personality and special routine. Try your hand at magic, face painting and balloon animals. Join the clown troupe on stage for a special performance!

DO YA' WANNA' ACT?: Happy :-) Sad :-(Act Up! Play around! Teri Burch will have you stretching your imagination to improvise and modernize stories and plays; using your voice, movement and characterization exercises leading to the creation and performance of a short play.

HIP HOP DANCE: Lisa Lee & Alyssa Wentz will teach the popular dance form Hip Hop. Students will learn the basics of the dance form: Poppin' and Lockin', the Top Rock, the Six Step and other dynamic moves.

JUGGLING AND MORE!: Learn to juggle bean bags, rings and clubs, to spin a diabolo, balance on a globe and ride a unicycle! David Groth teaches this extraordinary dexterity class.

MARIMBAS: Learn to play Zimbabwean-styled high energy music on marimbas, large wooden xylophone like instruments. Sally Sorensen and Tina Gospodnetich will help you have a truly amazing experience!

MAGIC : Join Master Illusionist, Jason Byers, on a journey into the mysterious world of Magic. You will learn the fundamentals of magic and illusion; learn how magic works and how to perform several effects with everyday objects.
